

How Do I Log In to Big Ideas? (Trouble? See “Troubleshooting Tip” at bottom.)

1. Go to portal.srvusd.net (this is the ONLY way to log in to Big Ideas – you cannot log in directly to the Big Ideas site, even though you’ll be taken there if your session times out).
2. Your username is ch.firstinitiallastname (Example: ch.kking)
3. Your password is originally ID#______, but you may have changed your password if you have already logged in to a school device.
4. The "Big Ideas Math" square should appear once logged in to the portal. If it doesn't, click on **SRVUSD Applications** at the top of the screen, then on the Big Ideas Math square (you should only ever have to do this once).
5. A picture of a textbook should appear; click on the appropriate one. If it doesn't appear, try clicking on the Big Ideas square again -- it should work the second time.
6. You should be on the Big Ideas site now; you'll see ten colorful rectangles.

How Do I Get to My Online Textbook? (Trouble? See “Troubleshooting Tip” at bottom.)

Log in using steps 1-6 above. One of the ten colorful rectangles is the “Student Dynamic E-Book”. This is the online version of your textbook; we’ll be using this often in class. The Table of Contents in the upper left allows you to navigate quickly to any section of the book (select the chapter, then hit “+” to select the section). Alternatively, you can put in the desired page number (if you know it) at the top of the screen.

How Do I Get to My Online Homework? (Trouble? See “Troubleshooting Tip” at bottom.)

Log in using steps 1-6 above. Above the ten colorful rectangles, you’ll see three tabs. Click on the “Assignments” tab to go to your online homework.

Homework Tips:

1. When you want to save or submit, click on your name; you’ll see a drop menu.
2. Save frequently, especially if you're going to be away from the computer for any amount of time! If you time out without saving, you’ll probably lose all of your progress.
3. Before you submit, take a picture with your phone of the screen, including homework title and progress bar; this can be your receipt in case the submission process fails.
4. When you submit, you should see a score -- if you do, the submission process was successful.
5. To look at homework assignments you’ve already submitted, go to the “Reports” tab instead.

Troubleshooting Tip: If you click a link and nothing happens, you probably have pop-ups blocked. Look at the right of the browser address bar and click on any icon that has a red “X” on it. Then click "Always allow pop-ups" (or “Allow unsafe scripts”), then "Done". You should only ever have to do this once.
